DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR CHILDREN ARE?

Please remember to keep your children in your eyesight at all times when they are playing outside. The office has been receiving numerous complaints about children damaging private property or hanging out in the streets and not moving out of the way when vehicles are driving through. All Careless actions such as the ones stated can be very dangerous and even fatal.

NEW RESIDENT INFORMATION

TRASH DAY: Wednesday. Trash container is put out Tuesday evening and returned to rear yard on Wednesday.

RECYCLING DAY: Alternating Wednesdays.

MAILBOXES: The Witchduck Postal Station on Columbus Street is responsible for issuing mail box keys. Their phone # 757-518-9848

TENNIS COURTS: Keys are at the office.

BOATS/TRAILERS: May NOT be parked in Campus East or Wesleyan Pines. Alternate storage will be required.

BASKETBALL HOOPS: In Campus East backboards may only be used and stored behind the rear foundation. In Wesleyan Pines, backboards are allowed on a case by case basis. Playing on public streets is prohibited by city code.

YARD/GRASS: Must be kept neatly cut and cracks kept weed and grass free, edged and beds weeded or it will be done at your expense.

PETS: Pets must be kept on a leash and by city ordinance you must clean up their droppings. Pick up the poop!

TRASH, TRASH & MORE TRASH



All garbage containers must be kept inside a privacy fence, shed, or garage behind the rear foundation. They shall not be permitted to be kept in front or side yards. Garbage containers must be neatly marked with the residence addressAdhesive numbers and letters at least 2" in height should be used for identification. Only the 90-gallon containers issued by the city will be picked up on trash collection day. All trash must be placed in these containers.

NO BLACK TRASH BAGS WILL BE PICKED UP ON TRASH DAY.

ALL YARD DEBRIS, GRASS CLIPPINGS AND LEAVES MUST BE IN CLEAR BAGS. THEY WILL NOT PICK UP BLACK BAGS

WASTE MANAGEMENT WILL NOT PICK UP ANY CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, CABINETS, CARPETING, DOORS OR TRIM BOARD.

TREE LIMBS MUST BE IN 4'x4'x4' PILES. NO TREE LIMB MORE THAN 6" IN DIAMETER OR TREE/SHRUB ROOTS WILL BE PICKED UP
